Claiming PDU's:

Use the following instructions to claim your PDU's. If you attended the entire day, you will be able to claim 7.50 PDU's:

- 1 Login to your PMI.org account
- 2 Under the Certification tab select Maintain your certification: Earn and report PDU's
- 3 You will be taken to PMI's Continuing Certification Requirements (CCR) System
- 4 Select Report PDU's
- 5 On the left navigation bar select "Report professional development units (PDU's)"
- 6 From the PDU Category menu pull down choose "Category A – Registered Education Provider"
- 7 From the Activity Type menu pull down choose "Find an Activity"
- 8 Click [Next] at the bottom of the page
- 9 In the "Activity Number" field enter the activity code (e.g. PMXP1301)
- 10 Click [Search]

From there, you'll be able to choose the specific program that you attended.

Alternatively, enter "gantthead" as the provider name, and this will give you a list of all activities that ProjectManagement.com (formerly gantthead) has offered.
